Covid 19 advice from the United Service Club: Evidence of full vaccination will have to be presented on entry for all visitors to the Club over the age of 16 years. We request that all Members ensure their guests to the Club are aware of the mandate prior to coming to the Club. This is a significant change and means that when visiting the Club or attending an event, it will be mandatory to present your Government-issued COVID-19 vaccination certificate on entry to the Club.

From the 19 th of November, you'll be able to link your vaccination certificate into your check-in Qld app. This will be the simplest method for those already using the check-in app.
